Academic details	Students take approx 24 credits. 1UWA=.5UT, 2=1, 3=2, 4=3, 6=4, 8=5, 9=6, 12=8	Credit system is 1:1, students generally take 5 courses, minimum is 4. Courses are in Spanish and English. A majority of courses are 20 and 10 credits. Be aware that some courses are year-long. Students MUST take ¼ of their courses in engineering
