# Enrollment & Graduation Statistics

*12th Class Day, Fall Semester 2011*

## Underrepresented Ethnic Minority (URM) Groups

- 20.2% of first year students are URMs (n=236)
- 19.9% of undergraduate students are URMs (n=1080)
- 5.3% of graduate students are URMs (n=117)
- 14.2% of 2010-11 undergraduate degrees were awarded to are URMs (n=148)

# Enrollment & Graduation Statistics

## Females

- 24.7% of first year students are women (n=288)
- 22.9% of undergraduate students are women (n=1243)
- 19.5% of graduate students are women (n=431)
- 21.3% of 2010-11 undergraduate degrees were awarded to women (n=221)
